ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

This matter comes before the Court on the Motion to Dismiss filed by Defendant Todd Rokita, in his official capacity as Indiana Secretary of State. The Court, having considered the Defendant's Motion and being duly advised in the premises, now GRANTS said Motion and makes the following findings:

1. Article 2, § 2 of the Indiana Constitution permits election regulations even if not specifically mentioned therein.


2. The Voter ID Law, Indiana Code § 3-11-8-25.1, is a procedural regulation, not an additional qualification on voting; therefore, the Law does not violate Article 2, § 2 of the Indiana Constitution.

3. Any "classes" of voters created by the Voter ID Law are not arbitrary or unreasonable but instead reasonably relate to self-evident inherent characteristics that distinguish the different classes.

4. All individuals within the different classes are treated similarly.
5. Accordingly, the Voter ID Law does not violate Article 1, § 23 of the Indiana Constitution.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff's Amended Complaint is hereby DISMISSED.
