

## Invitation to Participate in VOTE411

The League of Women Voters of Greater Lafayette (LWVGL) would like to invite you to participate in our 2023 primary election electronic voter guide called VOTE411.

We are using this web-based system so that you and other candidates may provide information and answer similar questions that will help voters gain a clearer impression of your platform. Each candidate for the same office is asked to answer the following questions by Friday, April 7, 2023.

LWVGL VOTE411 offers candidate questions and responses in English and Spanish. We ask that you respond to the questions in both English and Spanish if you have the ability and resources to do so. Separate areas are available in your web form to answer the questions in both languages. We would appreciate your assistance with this opportunity. If you are not able to complete your responses in Spanish, we will translate your responses for you. Once the translation is complete, we will send it to you to review and edit. We will then post the translation for you on VOTE411.

In your responses, only information about you, the candidate, should be entered. Do not enter information referring to an opponent either positively or negatively. Do not make any false, slanderous, or libelous statements. Do not upload copyrighted or other legally protected material without the permission of the owner of such material. Answers will be reviewed for compliance with these guidelines. If any changes are thought to be necessary, you will be contacted. No editing of your answers will be done by the League of Women Voters. Please do not use boldface, italics, underlining, hyphens, symbols, bullets, or lists. They may be changed to comply with *Voters' Guide* design layout.

Candidates are limited to 750 characters (including spaces and punctuation) for responses in English and Spanish. Your responses will be printed verbatim up to the character limit. Keep in mind that the Spanish requires approximately 125 more characters to say the same thing in English. The web form will count the characters for you and indicate when you have reached the limit.

You may submit a color or black and white “headshot” photograph for inclusion through VOTE411. Photos should not exceed 2MB and should be in .jpg format. The use of photographs in other print and online media is at the discretion of the League sanctioned publisher.

You will be able to see your completed responses prior to submission, and you will be notified when it is received. Please complete your responses by Friday, April 7, 2023 to be included in the online posting.

**Your responses and contact information will be available to voters 24/7 through an interactive, community specific online Voters' Guide at VOTE411.org and may be distributed by Leagues throughout the country in their local Voters' Guides and through other print and online media.**
